Work Areas : Categories A, D,E, Villages around IIT Kanpur campus;
Categories B, C, Villages in Kanpur, Kanpur Dehat, Unnao districts

Category A: Class 6-12, few students to be admitted in a year (number depending on sponsors), nurtured through school fee, textbooks, uniform etc.

Expense : Rs 15000 per student per year in the first 3 year, will increase afterwards

Category B: Class 9-12, 10 students to be admitted every year at class 9 level and nurtured through textbooks, postal assistance, summer camps, school fee etc.

Expense : Rs 12000 per student per year

Category C: Class 9-12, 30 students to be admitted every year at class 9 level and nurtured through textbooks and postal assistance

Expense : Rs 6000 per student per year

Category D: Sopan Vidyalaya : 50 students from pre school to class 6 level for kids in Barasirohi

Expense : Rs 3000 per student per year

Category E: Evening Learning Centers at SAC IITK, Barasirohi-I, Barasirohi II, Type-1 IITK and Chak Ratanpur. Total of 160 students from respective villages/localities

Expense : Rs 1500 per student per year

Talent is not a monopoly of elite section of the society. God has given talent irrespective of cast and creed, religion and geography. These boundaries are all artificial and human made which often prohibit the talent from coming to front. The responsibility of removing these virtual boundaries also lies with us. The objective of Pratibha Poshan Yojna is to bring ahead talent of the students of rural areas who cannot utilize the gift by the almighty because of the scarcity of resources, proper guidance and exposure. This Yojna would provide recognition to some such students and will help them in understanding themselves in a much better way.

This scheme aims at utilizing the huge human resource available in rural areas that goes waste due to non availability of information, resources and facilities. This would provide the students of rural area a chance to know more about the world and to expand their knowledge horizon. It will make them familiar to the modern technologies and would provide them with a very good exposure. In this way, these students will get motivation and direction in their life. This would in long term help them in becoming a good human being and a good citizen of India. Who knows if in future these kids catalyze the quality education chain reaction in India?

Category A:

Here a child will be selected early at the level of class 6 and all his expenses related to education up to 12 will be met by the sponsors. We estimate the expenses to be around Rs 15000 in the first three year and will increase to around 20000 in the next four years. The assistance will be continued till the student performs well.

Category B and C:

40 students going to class 9 will be selected by conducting tests in about 300 schools in rural areas adjoining Kanpur, having monthly fee below Rs100. This is to ensure that we target on the rural students with poor economic background. A second level test will be used to select 10 best promising students from these 40. Thus we will have 10 students in category B and 30 in Category C.

All the 40 selected students will be given a set of textbooks and through postal contact, their study progress will be monitored.

For the 10 selected students of category B, Shiksha Sopan will organize Summer camps where they will be given intensive training in Studies. Apart from their educational curriculum they will be given adequate activities in (a) Sports (b) Health awareness (c) Exposure to world events including scientific and technological advancements etc. This is to ensure their all-round development. They will also be help in school fee.

Category D:

Sopan Vidyalaya caters need of the poorest section of society by providing education with personality development programmes to their children upto class 6 for the time being. The children not only gain knowledge and become self confident, they also inculcate human values.

Category E:

This is a community service. Students going to various schools (mostly government school and low fee schools) collect in the evening for about 2 hours and the resource persons mostly IIK students help them in studies. Class 10 and 12 students are given special focus so that they can face the board examinations well.
