IISF 2024- scheduled to be held in Indian Institute of



Technology, Guwahati, during 30th Nov. to 03 December, 2024, resonating with its theme, 'Transforming India into a Science and Technology-Driven Global Manufacturing Hub' is poised to continue its illustrious journey, promising an exhilarating exploration of science and technology.

Every year Shiksha Sopan conducts this examination and distributes scholarship to the needy and bright students. The examination honors the memory of Late Dr. V.N. Kulkarni, former Professor of Physics at IIT Kanpur and a guiding figure for Shiksha Sopan. The goal is to enhance the educational quality of society by recognizing and rewarding academic talent. The examination conducted at 26 examination centers. Around 1300 students took this examination and more than 100 dedicated volunteers were involved in conducting the examination successfully. The result will be announced on 26th January, 2025. After this second level process of the selected students will start.

Academic Activities

1. Activities Conducted by Ms. Seema Verma:

- Class 7 students created a model to understand the local value of decimal numbers.
- Durgesh, Shiva, and Arya from Class 7 prepare a model to explain integer numbers. Seema ji used this model to teach the concept.
- Students from Class 5 to 8 were introduced to computer shortcut keys.
- Class 5 students learned the difference between open and closed figures and participated in an activity to calculate LCM.

2. Activities Conducted by Ms. Sunita:

❖ Students from Classes 6 to 8 were taught about the major rulers of the Mughal period, their contributions, and social and cultural features of the era.

- Class 5 students learned about judiciary importance, as well as the identification of Mughal-era buildings and related paintings.

Half Yearly Examination

After evaluation, the answer sheets were shown to the student to help them identify and understand their mistakes. This process aimed to ensure that the students learn from their errors and avoid repeating them in the future examinations.

Detailed discussion on the structure of the cell and its parts, explanation of the

shapes and sizes of cells, rokaryotic Cells: Simple cells without a well-defined nucleus, Eukaryotic Cells: Complex cells with a well-defined nucleus, Nucleus: The control center of the cell, Chromosome: Structures within the nucleus that carry genetic information.

Student Engagement:

- •The students learned several new scientific terms and their meanings.
- •The class enriched their understanding of fundamental biology concepts.

This session helped students build a strong foundation in cell biology, preparing them for advanced topics in the future.
