Science Cell

Science Teaching

Sopan Science team is developing effective teaching methodologies for science education. In this scheme our volunteers go to different places and give sessions on selected topics. Sopan team gave sessions on the chapter of Light at SAC evening centre for the students studying in class10th. Using short experiments they explained the basic laws of Light like reflection, refraction and image properties in various situations.

In the same scheme Shiksha Sopan has taken up science Classes of class 6 to 8 at SASK. Our volunteer Mr Deepak Mishra gives science classes on the topics in their books but in Sopan way of explaining things with the help of short experiments, SASK teachers also attend and participate in the process so that

from next session they can take it up on their own.

Dr H C Verma had also given classes on Light to the students studying in class 8th at Opportunity School, IIT Kanpur. The science teahers Mr Chaturbhuj, Mr Vaibhai, Mr Sambit, Ms Ananya and Mr Ratnakar attended the session and learned how topics like Fermat's Principle, straight line motion of light etc can be explained through experiments.
