Shiksha Sopan Higher Education Cell

Higher Education Cell is a program in which children from underprivileged section are given financial assistance to continue studies beyond class 12. In the current year we got 25 applications so far for the support. A subcommittee consisting of Dr Anurag Tripathi, Chemical Dept, Dr Rakesh Mathpal, Aerospace Engg Dept, Dr H C Verma, Mr Ranjan Upadhyay, Mr Anurag Pandey and Mr Amit Kumar Bajpai looked at the applications minutely in a meeting and selected 18 applications for support from Shiksha Sopan. In this year we collected a total of Rs 85,000/- till date from all our sources for HE cell and made a commitment of Rs 95,600/- for selected 18 students.

But as we got more applications and total requested amount from the applicants is Rs 4,16,312/-. In addition we might get occasional requests in the coming months. We have a committed donor related to one of the faculty member who is donating Rs 50,000 every year for HE Cell. However, we do need more donation to meet the current demands. We appeal the community to donate for this cell.

Three days Workshop at IIT Kanpur

A three day workshop from 10th to 12th September, 2016 was organized with combined efforts of Shiksha Sopan and Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT) for PGT teachers of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangthan. Dr H C Verma and Mr Anurag Pandey from Shiksha Sopan, Mr Amit K Bajpai and Mr Deepak Mishra from Anveshika and Mr Ranjit Kumar, Mr Atul Kumar, Mr Vipin Sharma from sopan science cell planned the experiments and their sequences.

Dr Verma gave sessions on science teaching modules. He discussed on optics, mechanics and Electromagnetism. He also showed a lot of experiments on these topics. Teachers were given hands on experience on the experiments, the entire responsibility of which was taken by the Science cell of Shiksha Sopan. A total of 30 PGTs from different KVs of Varanasi, Lucknow, Dehradun regions attended the programme.
